Hello Friends/Relatives,



Our elder, Tom Sampson on Vancouver Island in 2002 reminded us, 'The totem pole isn't what is Sacred. It's the gathering of the people around the Pole -- that is what is Sacred.' he said.

This year we invite you and your community to share in this sacred moment, as we prepare for our national tour: The Red Road to DC Totem Pole Journey to Protect Sacred Sites • July 13th thru August 4th, 2021. We are organizing a grassroots Pacific Northwest Tour (April 20 thru May 24) and proposing a West Coast/Oklahoma Tour (May 25 thru July 4th) and we'd love to visit your territory.
