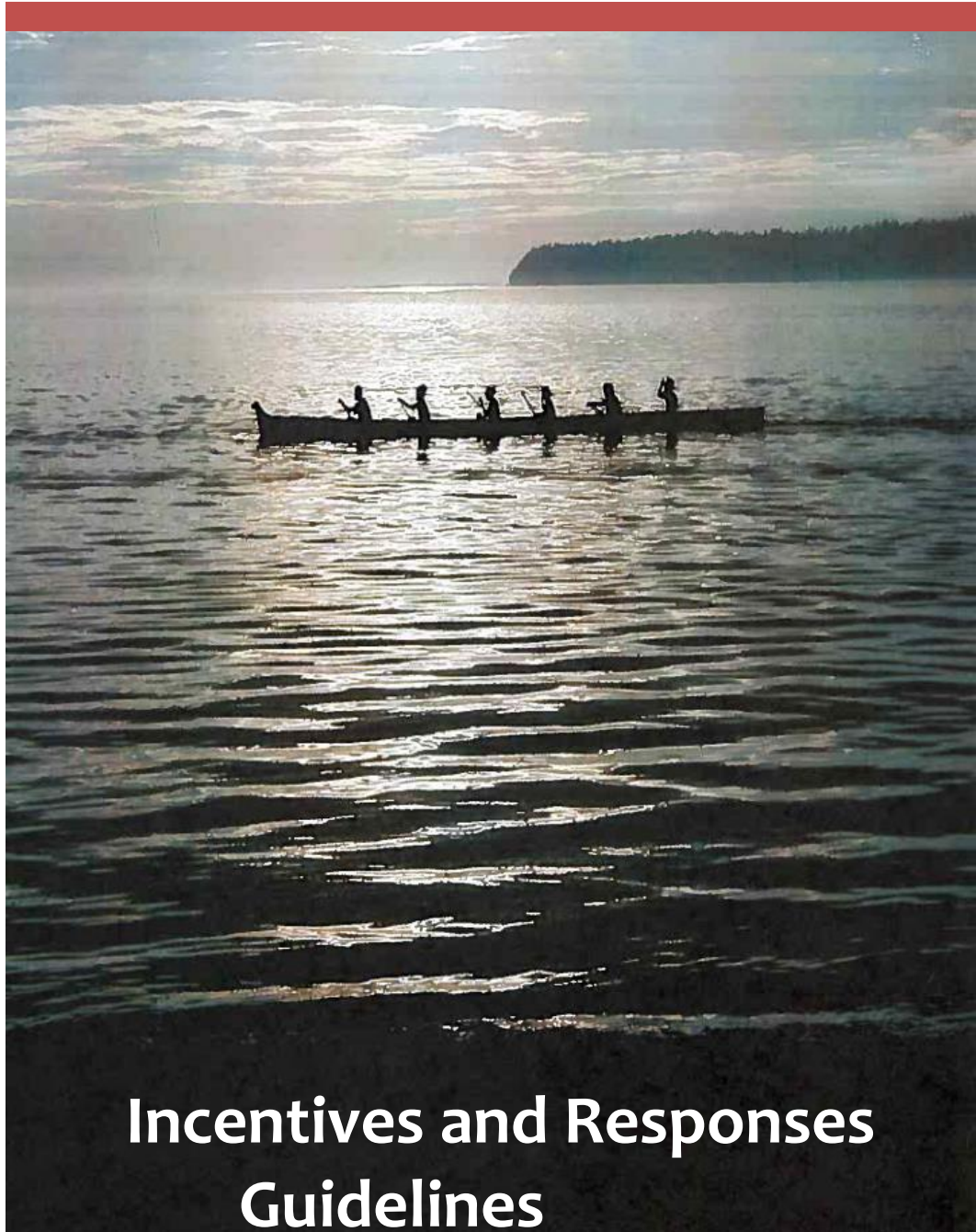

I. INCENTIVES (4:1 ratio for responses)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Example for other participants • Handshake • Allowed to leave Drug Court early • Verbal praise • Allowed to go first at court review 	<p><i>Any small and/or</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Written praise • Reduction in curfew • Star of the week • Get a gift from the fish bowl • Community Service voucher - 8 hours 	<p><i>Any small, medium, and/or</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get a gift from the bin (larger fish bowl) • Certificate of completion of stage • Community Service voucher- 16 hours
