HARVEST AREAS	Lummi Bay (7D) and the portion of Hale Passage running from the 7/7B line (Point Migley to Sandy Point) to a line running from the southern point of Portage Island to Smugglers Cove on Lummi Island.
FISHERY TYPE	Commercial
ON/OFF RESERVATION	On
LEGAL GEAR	Gill net, troll, hook and line
DAYS/HOURS	Monday, April 28th - Friday, May 2nd Open daily: 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM All fishers must check-in with sampler to receive permit before fishing. All fish must be made available for sampling.
TARGET HARVEST	Lummi Bay Hatchery released spring Chinook
RESTRICTIONS	1. Fishing by permit only 2. Must have a valid fish sticker to attain a permit 3. Acceptable gear: - Lummi Bay: troll, hook and line, and gill net (no part of your net may extend outside the bounds of 7D) - Hale Passage: troll only 4. All Salmonids (Salmon and Steelhead) caught must be retained 5. All fishers must check-in with sampler at the Cove and receive a permit before launching 6. All fishers must check out with sampler upon return; all catch must be made available for sampling 7. All Chinook will be marked with a unique tag by LNR staff 8. Only tagged fish may be bought or sold 9. Minimum mesh size: 6-inches 10. All provisions of Title 10 apply
JUSTIFICATION	Puget Sound Chinook Harvest Management Plan; Harvestable Surplus. Fishery will be managed to limit impacts to Nooksack River Chinook stocks of natural origin.
