All openings are scheduled for three hours before predicted low tide to three hours after predicted low tide.
TARGET HARVEST	2025 - 2026 BIVALVE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR PUBLIC TIDELANDS IN REGION 3: NORTH PUGET SOUND. Drayton West: 21,686 lbs of Manila clams or remainder of tribal share, whichever comes first.
EXPECTED EFFORT	40 diggers
RESTRICTIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. All provisions of Title 10 must be observed, including but not limited to:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Valid tribal fishing identification card with current validation sticker on person,</li><li>c) Check in with monitor before digging,</li><li>d) Check out with monitor after harvest, and</li><li>e) All clams transported from beach must be in sealed clam bag with monitor tag attached.</li></ol></li><li>2. All diggers entering the harvest area are subject to inspection to ensure that no outside shellstock is brought into the harvest area.</li><li>3. All diggers must comply with monitor's instructions concerning requirements of the National Shellfish Sanitation Program.</li><li>4. All harvesting equipment and shellstock storage areas shall be free of contaminants (e.g., petroleum products, toxic household products, animal waste, or decomposing shellstock from prior harvests).</li><li>5. Minimum size limit is 1.5 inches measured at the widest dimension of the shell.</li><li>6. Diggers shall backfill holes and flatten significant mounds.</li><li>7. Diggers will comply with monitor's directions for parking to minimize disruptions.</li><li>8. No garbage/waste will be left on the beach or in the adjacent park (Semiahmoo) except in proper receptacles.</li></ol>
JUSTIFICATION	This regulation is a Shellfish Implementation Plan paragraph 4.6 notice to proceed with harvest in the absence of a co-manager agreement for the 2026-2027 BIVALVE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR PUBLIC TIDELANDS IN REGION 3: NORTH PUGET SOUND.
