EFFECTIVE DATES	4/8/2026 to 6/15/2026
AFFECTED ORGANIZATIONS	WDFW, NMFS, Nooksack
HARVEST AREAS	Lummi Bay (7D) and the portion of Hale Passage running from the 7/7B line (Point Migley to Sandy Point) to a line running from the southern point of Portage Island to Smugglers Cove on Lummi Island.
FISHERY TYPE	Commercial
ON/OFF RESERVATION	On
LEGAL GEAR	Gill net, troll, hook and line
DAYS/HOURS	<u>OPENING TIMES</u> Fishery is open to fishers that have received Lummi Bay Commercial Chinook Permit from LNR. Permitted fishers may fish at any time pursuant to permit conditions.
TARGET HARVEST	Lummi Bay Hatchery released spring Chinook
RESTRICTIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Fishing by permit only2. Must have a valid fish sticker to attain a permit3. Acceptable gear:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Lummi Bay: troll, hook and line, and gill net (no part of your net may extend outside the bounds of 7D)- Hale Passage: troll only4. All Salmonids (Salmon and Steelhead) caught must be retained5. All fishers must receive permit from LNR prior to fishing6. All fishers must contact LNR to schedule sampling of any landed Chinook salmon; and no fish may be sold until it has been sampled7. Fisher must be willing to hold fish on ice until sampling can be scheduled and fish is sampled by LNR staff8. All Chinook will be marked with a tag by LNR staff9. Only tagged fish may be bought or sold10. Minimum mesh size: 6-inches11. All provisions of Title 10 apply
JUSTIFICATION	Puget Sound Chinook Harvest Management Plan; Harvestable Surplus. Fishery will be managed to limit impacts to Nooksack River Chinook stocks of natural origin.
