<b>EFFECTIVE DATES</b>	4/17/2026 to 10/15/2026
<b>AFFECTED ORGANIZATIONS</b>	WDFW, NWIFC, Point No Point Treaty Council, Suquamish, Tulalip, Swinomish, Port Gamble, Lower Elwha, and Jamestown Tribes
<b>AREAS</b>	Washington State Marine Fish and Shellfish Catch Reporting and Management Areas 25B, 25D and 26AW. This regulation opens a portion of the Lummi Nation usual and accustomed fishing grounds and stations (U&A). It is not, and should not be taken as, a statement of the limits of Lummi's U&A
<b>FISHERY TYPE</b>	Commercial
<b>SPECIES</b>	Non-Spot Pandalid Shrimp (coonstripe, sidestrip and humpback)
<b>EXPECTED EFFORT</b>	6 vessels
<b>TARGET HARVEST</b>	Tribal share: 6,000 pounds
<b>ON/OFF RESERVATION</b>	OFF
<b>DAYS/HOURS BY GEAR</b>	Pot Gear Only OPEN: As early as May 1st, 2026 CLOSE: October 15th, 2026, or when the treaty share is taken.
<b>RESTRICTIONS</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. FISHER ID MUST BE VALIDATED FOR SHRIMP.</li><li>2. MAXIMUM 100 POTS PER VESSEL.</li><li>3. SPOT SHRIMP CANNOT BE SOLD; NO SPOT SHRIMP MAY BE RETAINED ON BOARD THE HARVEST VESSEL.</li><li>4. ALL HARVEST MUST CEASE AT CLOSING.</li><li>5. IT SHALL BE A VIOLATION TO RETRIEVE POTS AFTER CLOSING WHILE THERE ARE SHRIMP ON BOARD THE VESSEL.</li><li>6. LUMMI NATURAL RESOURCES ENFORCEMENT MUST BE NOTIFIED OF THE NUMBER AND LOCATION OF ANY POTS LEFT IN THE WATER AFTER CLOSING DUE TO UNAVOIDABLE CIRCUMSTANCES TO AVOID A CITATION.</li><li>7. ALL CATCH MUST BE SOLD TO LUMMI REGISTERED BUYERS.</li><li>8. ALL SHRIMP MUST BE OFF LOADED WITH PROPER CATCH LOCATION NOTED AND RECORDED ON A FISH TICKET.</li><li>9. ALL POTS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE LUMMI NATURAL RESOURCES, AND NO MINIMUM MESH SIZE FOR POTS TARGETING NON-SPOT PANDILID SHRIMP AND NO MINIMUM MESH SIZE FOR ENTRY TUNNELS TUNNELS MUST BE LOCATED ON THE SIDES OF POTS</li><li>10. POTS SHALL BE ATTACHED TO A BUOY WITH THE FISHERS ID NUMBER AND THE NUMBER OF POTS, IF ATTACHED TO A GROUND LINE, CLEARLY VISIBLE EXCEPT IN EXTREME WEATHER OR TIDAL FLOWS.</li><li>11. ALL NON-SPOT SHRIMP INTENDED FOR PERSONAL USE (SUBSISTENCE) MUST BE REPORTED ON THE FISH TICKET AT LANDING.</li><li>12. MUST COMPLY WITH TITLE 10 REQUIREMENTS</li></ol>
<b>JUSTIFICATION</b>	This regulation is a Shellfish Implementation Plan paragraph 4.6 notice to proceed with harvest in the absence of a co-manager agreement for the 2026-27 Region 2W Pandalid Shrimp Harvest Management Plan and is promulgated pursuant to Chapter 10.6 of the Lummi Law and Order Code.
