HARVEST AREAS Lummi Bay (7D), Limited Areas of Hales Passage and Lummi Shore Road as defined below:

Hale's Passage: This area is defined by a western border of the Lummi Peninsula as far south as the southernmost point of Portage Island and extending as far north as the Sandy Point following the existing boundary of area 7D (Lummi Bay). The northwestern border is defined as a line extending between the westernmost extend of Sandy Point and Point Migley on Lummi Island. The western border of the area is defined as the eastern coast of Lummi Island as far south as the southern end of Smugglers Cove. The southern border is defined as a line between Smugglers Cove and the southernmost point of Portage Island.

Lummi Shore Road: This area is defined as no more than 1,800 ft from shore along Lummi Shore Road. The extent of this area is defined by a northernmost point at the intersection of Cagey Road and terminating at a southernmost point along the shore directly east of the southwest point of Brant Island.

RESTRICTIONS

1. Fishing by permit only
2. Must have a valid fish sticker to attain a permit
3. Acceptable gear:
 - 7D/Hale's Passage: troll, hook and line, and gill net (no part of your net may extend outside the bounds of 7D)
 - Lummi Shore Road: set gillnet (stake net) only
4. All Salmonids (Salmon and Steelhead) caught must be retained
5. All fishers must receive a permit from LNR before launching
6. All fishers must call or text number provided on permit to report catch and arrange sampling of any landed fish
7. All fish must be sampled by LNR staff
8. Minimum mesh size: 6-inches
9. All provisions of Title 10 apply
