(b) The sale of any quantity of clams.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1) Any Subsistence harvesters planning to harvest from areas with active Commercial clam openings MUST check in with the clam monitor
- 2) Subsistence harvesters will show clam monitor valid tribal fishing identification card.
- 3) Any Subsistence harvesters planning to harvest from areas with active Commercial clam openings MUST check out with the clam monitor
