<b>50 pounds</b> As per Title 10.14.080 Commercial Clam, Oyster, Bivalve Mollusk Harvest Definitions:
<ul> <li>a) Possession outside of the home of more than 50 pounds in the shell of manila clams, native littleneck clams, butter clams, cockles, mussels or oysters, or more than 50 pounds per day of shucked horse clams, or</li> <li>(b) The sale of any quantity of clams.</li> </ul>
50 diggers
<ol> <li>Any Subsistence harvesters planning to harvest from areas with active Commercial clam openings MUST check in with the clam monitor</li> <li>Subsistence harvesters will show clam monitor valid tribal fishing identification card.</li> <li>Any Subsistence harvesters planning to harvest from areas with active Commercial clam openings MUST check out with the clam monitor</li> </ol>
