2. MAXIMUM 100 POTS PER VESSEL.

3. SPOT SHRIMP CANNOT BE SOLD; NO SPOT SHRIMP MAY BE RETAINED ON

BOARD THE HARVEST VESSEL.

4. ALL HARVEST MUST CEASE AT CLOSING.

5. IT SHALL BE A VIOLATION TO RETRIEVE POTS AFTER CLOSING WHILE

THERE ARE SHRIMP ON BOARD THE VESSEL.

6. LUMMI NATURAL RESOURCES ENFORCEMENT MUST BE NOTIFIED OF THE NUMBER AND LOCATION OF ANY POTS LEFT IN THE WATER AFTER CLOSING

DUE TO UNAVOIDABLE CIRCUMSTANCES TO AVOID A CITATION.

7. ALL CATCH MUST BE SOLD TO LUMMI REGISTERED BUYERS.

8. ALL SHRIMP MUST BE OFF LOADED WITH PROPER CATCH LOCATION

NOTED AND RECORDED ON A FISH TICKET.

9. ALL POTS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE LUMMI NATURAL RESOURCES. AND NO MINIMUM MESH SIZE FOR POTS TARGETING NON-SPOT PANDILID SHRIMP AND NO MINIMUM MESH SIZE FOR ENTRY TUNNELS TUNNELS MUST

BE LOCATED ON THE SIDES OF POTS

 $10.\ \mathsf{pots}\ \mathsf{Shall}\ \mathsf{be}\ \mathsf{attached}\ \mathsf{to}\ \mathsf{a}\ \mathsf{buoy}\ \mathsf{with}\ \mathsf{the}\ \mathsf{fishers}\ \mathsf{id}\ \mathsf{number}$ AND THE NUMBER OF POTS, IF ATTACHED TO A GROUND LINE, CLEARLY

VISIBLE EXCEPT IN EXTREME WEATHER OR TIDAL FLOWS.

11. All non-spot shrimp intended for personal use (subsistence)

MUST BE REPORTED ON THE FISH TICKET AT LANDING.

12. MUST COMPLY WITH TITLE 10 REQUIREMENTS

JUSTIFICATION

This regulation is to pursue harvest under the co-manager agreement for the 2024-25 Region 2W Padalid Shrimp Harvest Management Plan and is promulgated pursuant to Chapter 10.6 of the Lummi Law and Order Code.
