JOB SUMMARY: Lummi Nation Schools is seeking a school psychologist with the ability to be an innovative leader and skilled at working with students and teams at the Kindergarten through 12 grade levels. Successful candidates will demonstrate the ability to support the teaching staff in delivering effective specialized instruction for all students and in designing effective programs for students with challenging behavior based upon the best available research and best practices.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITES: include the following, and other related duties as assigned.

- 1. Integrate information obtained during assessment into an accurate and useful overview to be used for determining program and service eligibility and interventions.
- 2. Complete psycho-educational evaluations.
- 3. Assist school counselor in completing Functional Behavioral Assessments.
- 4. Participate in Manifestation Determination meetings.
- 5. Complete Social/Emotional Evaluations.
- 6. Assist in developing 504 Plans.
- 7. Attend IEP and evaluation meetings.
- 8. Compile written reports integrating assessment results, observations, and other factors including professional judgment and recommendations of the IEP team.
- 9. Demonstrated ability to work effectively as a collaborative problem solver and member of an assessment/ IEP team.
- 10. Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively and collaborate with students, parents and staff.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Master in school psychology, educational psychology, or a related field in the appropriate area.
- Valid Educational Staff Associate certificate in school psychology.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver's License and meet eligibility requirements for tribal insurance.
