JOB SUMMARY: Under the direction and supervision of the Kitchen Manager: prepares and cooks healthy and well-balanced meals for students.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following, and other related duties as assigned.

1. Food prep for school meals.
2. Prepares cooks and serves school meals or side items.
3. Serves food portions according to USDA standards.
4. Monitors and records temperature for freezer and cooler.
5. As directed, cleaning and sanitizing of kitchen.
6. Ensures federal, state, and tribal food code regulations are followed.
7. Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have a valid Food Handler's Card, or able to obtain within 30 days of hire.
- USDA food services training *Preferred*
- First Aid, CPR card or must be willing to obtain one during orientation.
- Previous work experience with school students and teachers *preferred*.
- **Excellent** customer service – must be friendly, approachable and willing to listen to ideas to improve menu or operations.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

- Training in child nutrition, **HACCP** (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Points) codes.
- Ability to utilize, maintain and clean commercial kitchen equipment.
- Ability to maintain good working relationships with staff and students.
- Ability to work in a fast paced environment.
- Must be able to safely lift a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Ability to seek out work that needs to be completed.
- Ability to follow written and oral instructions.
- Knowledge of safety rules, regulations, and procedures as per USDA guidelines.
- Knowledge of safely using cleaning chemicals.
- Working knowledge of USDA meal pattern requirements.

- Must follow LIBC rules of conduct that will protect the interests and safety of all employees
- Demonstrated ability to work with Native American students, preferred.

REQUIRED:

- This position requires regular contact with or control over Indian children and is therefore subject to successful and extensive criminal background check, CAMIS background check, with Washington State Patrol and Federal Bureau of investigation Fingerprint Clearance.
- Must pass pre-employment and random drug and alcohol test to be eligible for and maintain employment, as required by the LIBC Drug & Alcohol Free Workplace Policy.
- Proof of U.S. Citizenship.
- Must be able to adhere to strict attendance expectations of the Lummi Nation School.
