## VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

**SUMMARY**: The responsibility of the exclusion code are two-fold: the first is to protect the health, safety and welfare of the Lummi Nation and the Lummi Reservation community; the second is to provide the person to be excluded with the motivation and means to seek treatment and rehabilitation so that their conduct may no longer be a threat to the health, safety and welfare of the Lummi Nation

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES** include the following, and other related duties as assigned.

- 1. Participate on committee at various times to listen to cases being brought forward, make a decision whether the contingent order is necessary or full Exclusion or no Exclusion.
- 2. Participate on the committee to determine if temporary entry should be allowed or denied
- 3. Take part in deciding whether conditions of an exclusion have been met, and whether re-entry is appropriate

#### MAKE-UP OF POOL

• Seven community persons are appointed to be on the Exclusion Hearing Committee

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be an enrolled member of the Lummi Nation who is living on the Lummi Reservation or is actively and substantially involved in activities taking place on the Lummi Reservation;
- Be a respected member of the community;
- Possess a thorough knowledge of Lummi cultural values and practices;
- Have no prior history of felony criminal acts; no history of any criminal acts within the previous five years and no pending criminal charges
- Must be available to attend court proceedings in an exclusions trial for which that person is designated as a panel member and meetings scheduled for pool members
- Must be willing and able to maintain confidentiality of matters that come before the committee
- Lummi/Native American/Veteran preference policy applies.

#### PERIOD OF APPOINTMENT

- Initial appointments to the committee will be for staggered periods ranging from 1 to 3 years, so that the terms of the positions do not end at the same time.
- Please indicate in your letter of interest if you would prefer to be appointed to a term shorter than three years.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must pass pre-employment and random drug and alcohol test to be eligible for and maintain employment, as required by the LIBC Drug & Alcohol Free Workplace Policy.
- Position requires extensive Criminal Background Check.
- Applicant must submit Letter of Interest and proof of enrollment.
